## payroll giving

Are you giving  
as much as you think?

Payroll giving has great tax benefits. However the tax benefit is felt by you, rather than the charities you have chosen to receive the gifts.

You may like to turn this advantage to the benefit of the charity. You can do this by increasing your donation. The charity receives more money, but it still only costs you what you originally had in mind.

### basic rate tax payers

$$\text{your amount} \div 80 \times 100$$

#### Example one

Thinking of a £40 donation?

$$40 \div 80 \times 100 = \text{£}50$$

A gift of £50 (-2.5% admin fee)

can therefore be made at a cost of just £40!

### higher rate tax payers

$$\text{your amount} \div 60 \times 100$$

#### Example two

Thinking of a £40 donation?

$$40 \div 60 \times 100 = \text{£}66.66$$

A gift of £66.66 (-2.5% admin fee)

can therefore be made at a cost of just £40!
