Stewardship

A **biblical** world view of stewardship can be consciously defined as:

"Utilising and managing all resources God provides for the glory of God and the betterment of His creation."

Charles Bugg, "Stewardship" in Holman Bible Dictionary (Holman: Tennessee, 1991), 1303-1304




Active Stewardship

A three-way partnership

- **givers** (Generous and faithful stewards)
- receivers (Missional and faithful stewards)
- provider (God provides all generosity personified)







Discipleship and money



Who is our teacher when it comes to money and mission?

- Culture (family, business, consumer, regional or national cultures)
- Church (poverty)
- Scripture (faith in action)

Matthew 6: 24

"No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money."

Luke 12: 15

Then he said to them,
"Watch out! Be on your guard
against all kinds of greed; life does
not consist in an abundance of
possessions."



Spiritual battleground



Matthew 6: 24 and Luke 12: 15

- money is a rival god (Mammon)
- mammon Beware of 'stuff' (possessions, fame, status, whatever is more important that Jesus)
- recognise the lure of money (remember those that have fallen!)

2 Corinthians 8: 1-5 and 22-24

- v1-5: A different approach to money: the "Macedonian equation"
- v23: personal representatives 'of the church and an honour to Christ'
- V24: so 'the churches can see it'





Attitude sickness

Being culturally conditioned and not biblically conditioned with money

- leaders not seeing the transformational power of generosity
- don't make disciples in this area
- wrongly motivated and misunderstood
- existing to serve itself, its members or leaders becomes isolated in the community
- members / supporters just won't want to give generously



Administration

2

- 2 Corinthians 8: 19 'to honour the Lord Himself'
- 'to administer in order to honour the Lord'
- serve the leadership and the mission
- good administration without which things go wrong





Administration sickness

Failing to handle things in an efficient and safe way

- poor stewards of people's generosity
- mis-spent or misappropriated, and even fraud (it happens).
- members / supporters lose confidence
- Finance is a team game don't rely on a single treasurer



Accountability

2

2 Corinthians 8: 20-22

- · 'to avoid any criticism'
- 'to do what is right in the eyes not only of God but also of men'
- in the sight of God (the heart) in the sight of others (reputation)

"We want to avoid any criticism of the way we administer this liberal gift. For we are taking pains to do what is right, not only in the eyes of the Lord but also in the eyes of man."



Accountability sickness

2

Little openness and transparency

- finances are handled by a single person
- financial information is not shared widely with others
- final decisions are taken behind closed doors, leading to suspicion
- we fail to do what is right in the eyes of man
- the unthinkable does happen

One size doesn't fit all

- Full stipend / Employed (part time also)
- Bi-vocational (Tent-making)
- Anticipatory
- Pledges / fundraising
- Raising Personal support (MPD)

- Volunteer
- Co-vocational
- Business as Mission
- Living by faith (asking only God for finances)
- Not an exhaustive list



What is raising personal support?



One who raises support to enable ministry by establishing partnerships with people who help to support them

- **≻**Biblical
- ➤ Highly relational
- > Prayer, encouragement and financial support
- ► Individual Partner Account & Support Raising Training
- ➤ Ministry Partner Development (MPD)





Why consider MPD model?

3

- ➤ Training for ministry or Christian work
- ➤ God calls individuals to serve in the body
- ➤ Newcastle United
- ➤ Collective involvement and support
- ➤ Money needs and heart issues





MPD benefits to church planters...



- increases ability to recruit more leaders, more quickly with less resources
- > seamless launchpad from self funded training (theology etc) straight into funded ministry
- > decreases central funding needs and fundraising burden
- replication is simple, scalable and sustainable
- release more people into ministry than just church leaders this is for anyone in Christian ministry so get creative!



Ministry Partner Development (MPD)

Needs

When doing theological training, your immediate needs are not your only need.

- Personal living Costs
- Theology course fees

Your training is equipping you for future Christian work / ministry.

Catalyst

You become a living catalyst for generosity and an opportunity for people to be blessed by partnering with you. This is not just about money but Partnership in the gospel

Relationship

Talking about ministry and money is not easy but incredibly valuable.

Developing long term relationships from training into ministry can form deep friendship, valuable prayer support and a faith based financial foundation

Ministry Impact

It's not only about the impact of your ministry. Partnership with others releases you to accomplish His plan by His grace. That's humbling and keeps you dependent on God

and minds and culture is crucial

Partnership

One body, many parts.
Others can get involved in helping to fulfil the vision God has given you.
This partnership gives them the opportunity to faithfully steward their resources and advancing God's Kingdom through you

Longevity

Your training equips you in or for ministry. Raising your own financial support relationally gives you the ability to spring into ministry with a support base already behind you, giving you confidence in God's provision and faith when it comes to money and finance




